Easter in Poland



One of the most popular Easter traditions in Poland is preparing an ¹  with many symbols of Easter inside. People put ² , bread, some sausage, ³  and a sugar ⁴  inside their baskets. There is often a chocolate ⁵  or an ⁶  inside too. Children decorate the ⁷  with flowers and ⁸  and take them to ⁹  on Easter Saturday. On Easter Sunday, people eat Easter breakfast, share an egg and wish each other lots of happiness. On ¹⁰ , people pour water on each other for good luck!

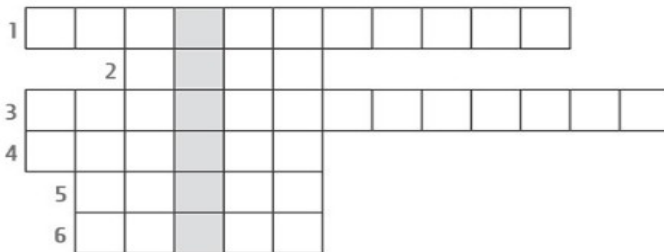
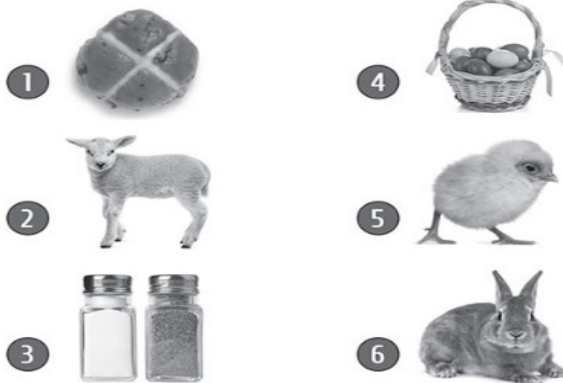
Easter in Britain



Easter is an important spring festival in Britain. The Easter holiday is usually two weeks long! On the Friday before Easter, people in Britain eat ¹ . People also make ²  and hide them in their gardens. They hide chocolate eggs too. People don't prepare an ³  but Easter Sunday starts with an ⁴  when children look for eggs in the garden. Also on Easter Sunday, an ⁵  brings some presents for the children – chocolate ⁶ , ⁷  or some other small gifts. Easter Monday is not ⁸  but children may go ⁹ . They put an ¹⁰  at the top of a hill and let it roll down the hill. The winner is the first egg that gets to the bottom of the hill.
